Lunch Policy

Tá an-chuid cainte na laethanta seo faoin mbia a thugar dár bpáistí le hithe. Mar is eol daoibh tá polasaí lóin shláintiúil againn i nGaelscoil na Camóige le fada an lá. **Níl cead ag páistí aon bhia nó deoch nach bhfuil sláintiúil a thabhairt ar scoil. Níl cead acu aon chnónna a thabhairt isteach** ach an oiread. Seo liosta den bhia nach bhfuil ceadaithe. Má tá tú amhrasach faoi aon rud eile labhair leis an oifig nó cur nóta chuig an Múinteoir Ranga le do thoil.

There is a lot of talk these days about what we are feeding our children. At Gaelscoil na Camóige we have had a successful healthy lunch policy in operation for many years now. Children are only permitted to bring drinks and foods to school that are healthy. Food containing nuts are also not permitted. If you are unsure of any foods please do not hesitate to check with the office or with the class teacher. Below is a list of foods that are not permitted.

Lón Te/ Free Hot Lunch Scheme

As you know, the Free Hot Lunch Scheme was introduced last year, in conjunction with Glanmore Foods. Every child is entitled to a Hot Lunch.

Please make sure to choose your child's food from the Glanmore App. Also, please ensure that your child likes the choice, and if not, change the meal accordingly.

Children will need a healthy drink and snack for the morning break each day.

An Ghaeilge

Is cúis bród dúinn é go labhraíonn páistí na scoile Gaeilge go nádurtha ar scoil, ar chlós na scoile, lena cairde. Ta sé ríthábhachtach go gcoinnítear an caighdeán ard seo. Déantar seo tré mholadh, duaiseanna, meabhrucháin, tacaíocht ón mbaile. Tá córas iompair againn sa scoil, áit a ghearrtar píonóis ar pháiste mas rud é go bhfuil sé soiléir nach bhfuil sé/sí ag déanamh iarracht i dtaobh an Ghaeilge de. Má chloistear páiste ag spalpadh Béarla (R2-R6) gheobhaidh siad cárta bán. Iarrtar ar thuismitheoiri tacú linn, an cárta a shíniú agus labhairt le do pháiste faoin tábhacht a bhaineann leis an nGaeilge.

Tá tacaíocht na dtuismitheoirí an-thábhachtach le cabhrú linn caighdeán ard Gaeilge a choinneáíl sa scoil.

The amount of spoken Irish amongst the children in our school is a constant source of pride for the school community. The children speak Irish naturally, on the yard, amongst their friends. It is extremely important that the amount of Irish spoken is maintained as it can be a common challenge for Gaelscoileannna. How do we encourage the children to speak as Gaeilge? Our children speak as Gaeilge due to the constant motivation and praise from staff, prizes, reminders and of course support from home. As you know we have a Discipline Code in the school, whereby a Cárta Bán/White Card is issued to a child if they are speaking in English and it is clear that the child did not make any effort to speak in Irish. If a child is overheard speaking in English, (from Rang 2- Rang 6) they will be issued a White card. We ask that parents support this system, sign the card and speak to your child about why you chose a Gaelscoil for them and how important it is to try to speak Irish. Parental support is vital to ensure that Irish is of a high standard always in Gaelscoil na Camóige.

An Clós / The yard

níl cead ag daoine fanacht timpeall teach an Áras ar maidin.

Parents/ guardians are not permitted to stay on the school yard in the mornings. Please drop your child to the yard and leave. We also remind parents not to stay around the front of the Áras/ on the driveway etc. in the morning time. Supervision is provided on the yard every morning.

Tá lán fáilte roimh thuistí agus páistí óga fanacht i gclós na scoile ag 1.25i.n. Tá sé riachtanach, áfach, go bhfanfaidh na páistí lena dtuismitheoirí thuas ag an ngeata go ciúin. Bíonn ceachtanna ar siúl sna seomraí agus cuireann an torann isteach ar na páistí istigh. Níl cead ag páistí dul taobh thiar de sheomraí aon rang, am ar bith.

Parents and siblings are welcome to wait in the yard at 1.25pm for the infants to finish. Please do not arrive into the yard earlier than 1.25pm. It is essential that children wait quietly with their parents near the gate as classes are still continuing and the noise in the yard can be disruptive. Children are not allowed to go behind any class buildings at any time. Children are not allowed cycle bikes or scooters across the yard.
